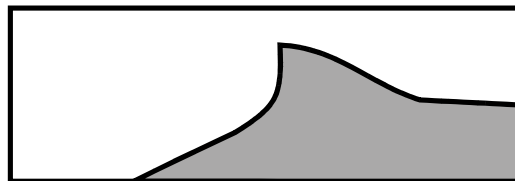

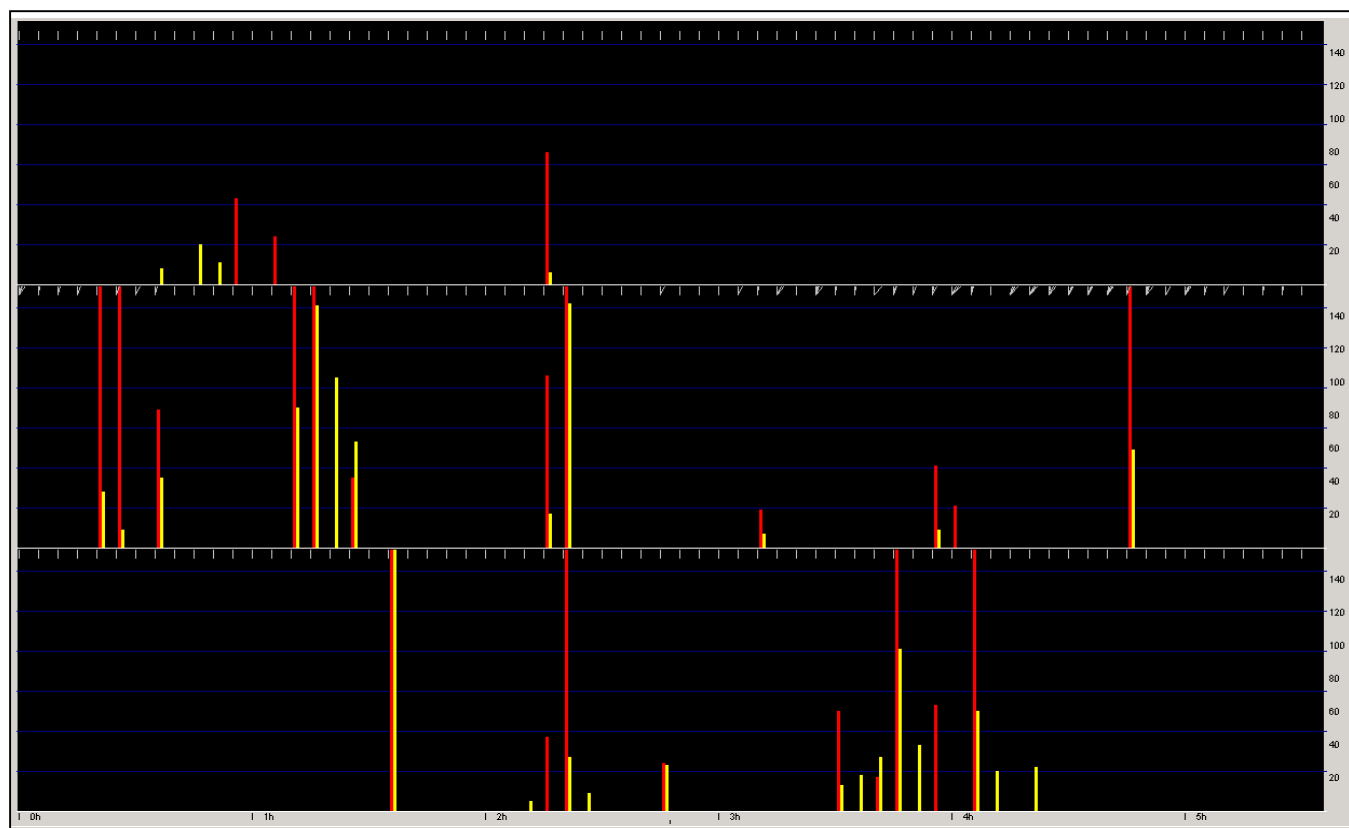


Figure showing TPOD output. The red peaks correspond to high probability porpoise click detection. Yellow is medium probability. Timescales are synchronous, suggesting porpoise activity at Port Talbot (top), Carmarthen Bay (middle) and Bury Holms (bottom) within minutes of each other – i.e. different porpoise groups. Resolution of time axis – 5 minutes.
